3.	Board Trustee Update	Mario P
•	Mario P invited members to ask questions and put forward items they would like tabled with the Board	
•	Query re: screen time for younger students and best practices; Government has mandated 180m of online learning; this translates to a significant amount of continuous screen time for JK and Gr1 students; parents requesting more flexibility to help minimize screen time; noted that this varies between classes/teachers; Mario suggested raising with principal	
•	Trustee asked for an update on plans for First Communion and Confirmation sacraments	
•	Church is taking the lead; parents connected directly with church; virtual sessions being held to prep kids for First Communion; parents have been given materials to help prepare kids at home; no dates set yet	
•	No information re: Confirmation yet; anticipate early February	
•	Query re: how/if student evaluations will be adapted to generate marks; especially how attendance will be factored in; lack of presence online doesn't mean child is not doing school work	
•	Query re: Public Health rules for when kids return to school (e.g. testing)	
•	Mario P indicated that the Board is anticipating new information from Public Health in the near future and that it will be distributed shortly after	
4.	Principal's Update	Mrs. Gizzi



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- School currently has approximately 400 students participating in virtual classes; 7 needs moderate students are participating in classes in-person at school
- Virtually classes are going well; technological issues are being resolved continually; more tech tools have been ordered (e.g. tripods)
- Online tentatively until Feb 10
- Re: First Communion, Confirmation and First Reconciliation; parents directed to connect with Bev O'Grady directly through the church
- Faith and wellbeing are key themes for this year; virtue assemblies are now online; virtue of self-control is the focus in February; Black history assembly tentatively planned for February
- Reporting for term 1 planned for Feb 9; likely electronically; marking has been adapted to make evaluation possible given all the classroom rearrangements that took place
- Advent mass was held on Dec 16 virtually with Father Terry
- Planning mass with St. Dominic's and St. Paul's; Live stream hopefully for ash Wednesday
- Donation from Council supported about 10 families with winter apparel/needs over the holiday period
- High school registration underway now; FDK registration also underway
- Spirit week planned for next week; funds raised will be donated to ShareLife
- Acknowledged efforts of teachers and efforts made to make transition to virtual classes as seamless as possible
- New retirements: Miss Savage, Miss Moral retiring at end of the month
- Proposed to eliminate February meeting given students are not inschool; Next meeting March 24 (cathy C, and Debbie second)
- Question: Will attendance online impact evaluation of students?
- Answer: No, this will not adversely impact grades if students are completing work off-line; especially for smaller kids; teachers are taking this into consideration
- Question: Given that parents are playing a more active role in the virtual classroom, it would be helpful for teachers to provide direction to parents re: role (e.g. how to submit material to help facilitate marking, etc.)
- Tip parents should get Google classroom on their phone; makes it easier for parents to track and also submit work on behalf of child
- Each family is different and has different needs; families are encouraged to do what works best for them
